WHO CAN APPLY

All current members of the Washington Air National Guard and those eligible to join.

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following criteria must be met as of closeout date of this announcement to be considered:

- Applicants must possess 11M3F AFSC
- Meet ANG fitness standards IAW AFI 36-2905 with a score of 75 or above (*applies only to current members of the USAF, USAFR or ANG*)
- Possess or be able to obtain a **TOP SECRET** security clearance

SUMMARY OF DUTIES

This position is located at the Wing level in the ANG Aviation Wing at selected Air Mobility Command (AMC) gained flying units in the Air National Guard (ANG). The primary purpose of the position is to support the Air Commander directed activities in the wing flight/ground safety office. Maintains an operational dialogue with National Guard Bureau (NGB), gaining commands, and supported organizations concerning plans, programs and inspection activities. Serves as Air Commander's representative when performing duties as: Flight Safety Officer, Operations Supervisor (OS), Supervisor of Flying (SOF); is responsible for the safe and efficient mission accomplishment of the unit through the use of an Operational Risk management (ORM) program. Provides ground and flight instruction in KC-135. Administers combat flight training to military aircrews. Assesses flight instructors, pilots and other aircrew members assigned, attached, or newly acquired to the unit to determine flying proficiency in unit assigned aircraft. Maintains a thorough knowledge of airplane systems and procedures under normal, instrument, and emergency conditions. Gives timely and accurate instruction to aircrews during air and ground operations. Briefs and instructs preflight preparations including: intelligence briefings, mission planning, weather factors, mission objectives, and other agency coordination items to ensure safe and effective mission accomplishment. Performs other duties as assigned.

Will be required to attend Chief of Safety Course preferably within 90 days of assignment, but no later than 180 days. Other schools/courses as required.



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ELEMENTS

The following elements are considered essential for successful performance in this position. Response to the Elements is voluntary, however written response to each of the following Elements will ensure that specialized experience is recognized.

- Ability to maintain currency on primary weapons system
- Ability to work closely in a Joint and/or Total Force Integrated (TFI) environment
- Knowledge of Inspector General Program, participate as Wing Inspection Team for Commanders Inspection Program
- Knowledge of wing safety programs; OSHA, BASH, ORM
- Knowledge of and experience in Air National Guard Leadership and management concepts, practices and objectives
- Knowledge of strategic planning at the Wing, State and National level

- 5) Point Credit Summary (PCARS) from the vMPF under Record Review. Print "View All", minus the PCARS definitions and FAQ pages (*only applies to current members of the USAFR or ANG*)
- 6) Current Report of Individual Fitness (*only applies to current members of the USAF, USAFR or ANG*)
- 7) Response to Job Elements (*not required, but highly encouraged*)
- 8) NO BINDERS OR BOUND DOCUMENTS

- Enlistment/Appointment in the Washington Air National Guard is a condition for retention in the AGR program.
- Potential for promotion in the position is conditional upon assignment to the appropriate UMD grade, compliance with ANGI 36-101 grade compatibility requirements and, if applicable, the availability of an AGR control grade. Selection for the position at a higher grade does not automatically constitute the immediate availability of an AGR control grade required for promotion to the higher grade.
- The process of applying and being nominated does not constitute final selection for nor guarantee this position. Applicants are strongly advised not to make arrangements to move or change jobs until notified of final selection by the Adjutant General of the State of Washington or designated representative.
- Applicants should be able to complete 20 years of active federal service prior to Mandatory Separation Date (MSD) for officers, age 60 for enlisted. If unable to meet this requirement a statement of understanding must be completed prior to start date.
- Military grade cannot exceed the maximum military grade authorized. A member who is overgrade must indicate, in writing, a willingness to be administratively reduced in grade when assigned.
