This position is located in an Information Operations Squadron. This unit helps protect the nation's war-fighter information systems, computer networks and installation critical infrastructure. Purpose of position is to serve as a senior maintenance team member and advisor to the Superintendent providing career development and upgrade recommendations to squadron leadership. Provides networked application resources by designing, configuring, installing, and managing data services, operating system and server applications. Performs system resource management, to include load and capacity planning and balance. Creates, administers, and audits system accounts. Performs strategic and budget planning for systems hardware and software. Coordinates and implements system service level agreements and memoranda of understanding with user agencies to ensure squadron readiness for Cyber Protection Teams (CPT) for the Department of Defense worldwide. Serves as advisor at meetings for facility design, military construction programs and minor construction planning. Evaluates base comprehensive plan and civil engineering projects as a part of CPT mission and other operational tasking's. Provides leadership with recommendations and guidance on technical and personnel issues. Trains and evaluates personnel in technical skills, management and leadership. Organizes and manages personnel, technical and administrative tasks. Performs other duties as assigned.
