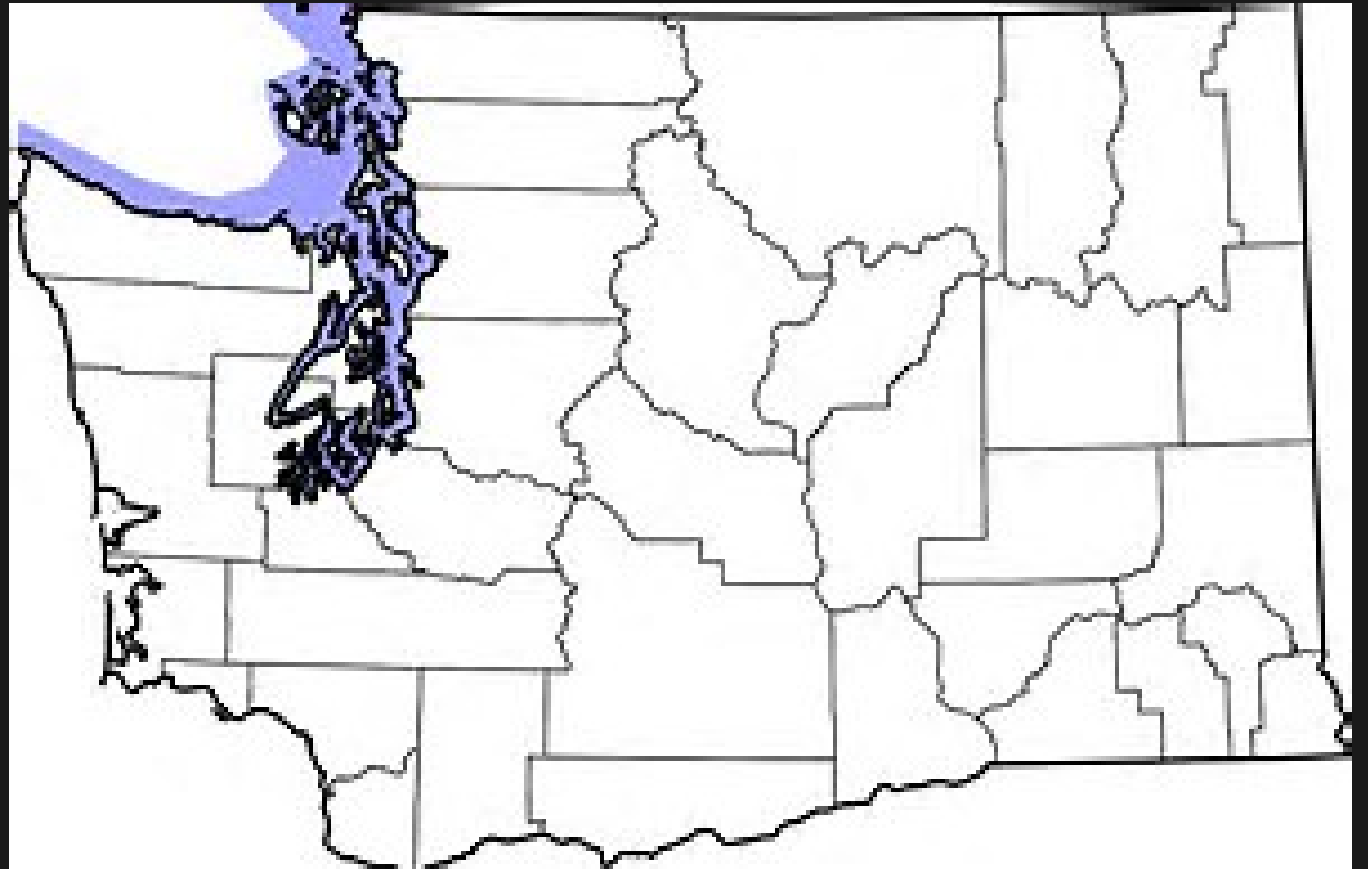
CCTA Application Process
