#### <u>Purpose</u>


Provide the Emergency Management Council awareness of Federal Fiscal Year 2017 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) funding allocations.

#### **HSGP Grant Overview**

- Grant guidance has not been released. A continuing resolution is in effect until April 28<sup>th</sup>. Expecting guidance shortly after with a condensed application period.
- 80% of funding dedicated to locals, 20% to state
- 5% management and administration cap
- 50% personnel cap
- 25% minimum for law enforcement terrorism prevention activities
- Key focus:
  - Prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events
  - Prepare the Nation for threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to security and resilience of the United States and the greatest risks along the Nation's borders
