He successfully served in various battery officer positions, including Battery Commander while on active duty. During his service in the Washington Army National Guard he has served in battery positions of Executive Officer and Battery Commander; at the battalion level in the positions of Communications Officer, Assistant S3, S3, Executive Officer and Battalion Commander of a Mechanized Infantry Battalion. He also served as G4 and G3 of an Emergency Operations Headquarters, Mechanized Infantry Brigade S3 and Executive Officer, as a Task Force Commander of a Support Center, Rear Area Operations unit and as a Section Chief and the Commander of a Command and Control Headquarters unit.
