Brigadier General Barlow was born 16 July 1939 in Charleston, West Virginia. He graduated from Burien High School, 1957 and attended two years at Gonzaga University in Spokane. He transferred to Seattle University, which he attended seven years, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in 1964 and a Masters of Arts Degree in 1966.

While attending College in 1964, Barlow enrolled in the ROTC program at Seattle University and was commissioned Second Lieutenant on 31 July. After graduation in 1966 BG Barlow went on active duty, attending Airborne Training, and Flight Training and tour with the 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne) in Can Tho, Viet Nam. Barlow finished his active duty service as Executive Officer/Avaitor, at Hunter Army Air Field, Georgia.

BG Barlow entered the Washington Army National Guard as a Team Leader, Aero Scout Section, 81st Avn Company on 10 Jan 70. He continued service as a Rotary Wing Pilot-540th Avn Company-Section Leader, Asst S2 and Avn Officer 81st Avn Company-Training Officer, S-3 for 3-161 Sept 77 until Nov 79, and XO for 3rd Bn, 161st Inf from Dec 79 to Jul 80. In Aug 1980 he returned to the 81st Brigade as Civil Affairs Officer. He transferred in July 1981 and took command of the 1st Bn 803rd Armor Battalion. After battalion command he returned to the 81st Brigade as the Deputy Brigade Commander from July 84 to Feb 1985. An appointment as the State Assistant Adjutant General, Army took him to State Headquarters, Mar 85 to November 1986. BG Barlow was assigned to the 81st Infantry Brigade (M) as Brigade Commander in November 1986.
