FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

OCTOBER 15, 2015

Today, October 15, 2015, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of Washington triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from the Severe Windstorm that occurred on August 29, 2015. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number: FEMA-4242-DR

Incident: Severe Windstorm

Incident Period: August 29, 2015

Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or

replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

PA-Designated Counties: Island, Jefferson, and Snohomish Counties.

Hazard Mitigation (HM): (Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term

risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas: All areas in the State of Washington are

eligible for assistance under the Hazard

Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date if

requested by the State and warranted by the results of further

damage assessments.
