At the conclusion of the assignment, each member of the SDCFP provides group/individual briefings to the Secretary of Defense/Deputy Secretary of Defense, Service Secretaries and Chiefs, and over three dozen other senior OSD and service leaders on private industry best practices and the fellow's assessment as to their applicability to transform the Department of Defense.
