Mission Areas

- ❑ **Prevention**
Avoid, prevent or stop a threatened or actual act of terrorism
- ❑ **Protection**
Protect the homeland against natural and manmade disasters or acts of terrorism
- ❑ **Mitigation**
Reduce the loss of life and property by lessening the impact of disasters
- ❑ **Response**
Save lives, protect property and the environment, and meet basic human needs after an incident has occurred
- ❑ **Recovery**
Assist communities affected by an incident to recover effectively

Select Core Capabilities

❑ **Operational Communications**

Ensure the capacity for timely communications in support of security, situational awareness, and operations by any and all means available, among and between affected communities in the impact area and all response forces.

Select Core Capabilities

❑ **Cybersecurity**

Protect, and if needed, restore electronic communications systems, information, and services from damage, unauthorized use, and exploitation.

❑ **Infrastructure Systems**

Stabilize critical infrastructure functions, minimize health and safety threats, and efficiently restore and revitalize systems and services to support a viable, resilient community.

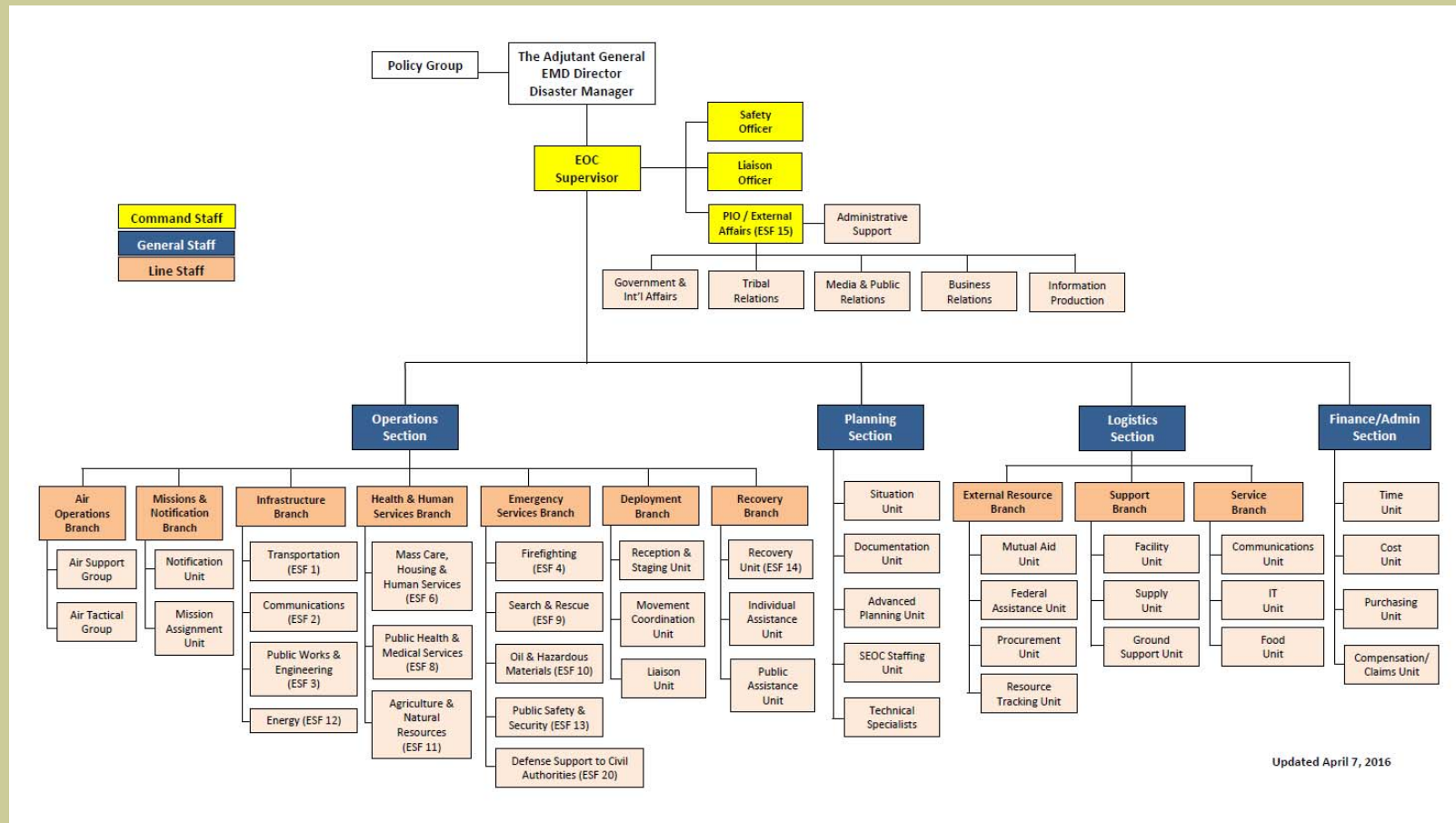
