Plans, supervises, and participates in vision conservation and eye protection programs according to AFI 41-210, Tricare Operations and Patient Administration Functions and AFJI 44-117, Ophthalmic Services. Manages and directs aerospace and operational vision programs. Supports the Flight and Operational Medicine and Medical Standards Management Element with flying class and special operations physicals, aeromedical waivers for vision and ocular conditions, and other vision services.</p>
