Develops plans, policies, procedures, and detailed instructions to implement DSG programs. 5. Involved in planning, organization, and scheduling of all Regularly Scheduled Drills (RSD) to include providing oversight/guidance. 6. Individual selected will perform and participate as a crewmember and/or perform other staff duty functions. 7. Possess knowledge and skill in applying techniques to identify, analyze and resolve issues to personnel conflict and management. 8. Possess knowledge of Washington State National Guard and associated capabilities to include experience. 9. Have the ability to deal effectively with personnel at various levels of command, both verbally and in writing. 10.
