Proposal

Change Washington's Tier Two form

Expand chemical hazard categories

 From 5 physical and health categories to 24 (13 physical and 11 health).



Expanding hazard fields would

- Match OSHA's updated safety data sheets (SDS)
- Allow reporters to report hazards as listed on new SDS and not crosswalk back to old fields
- Provide first responders with better information about chemical hazards

Physical Hazards	Health Hazards
Explosive	Acute toxicity

Self-reactive	Respiratory or skin sensitization
Pyrophoric	Germ cell mutagenicity
Self-heating	Carcinogenicity
Organic Peroxide	Reproductive toxicity
Corrosive to metal	Specific target organ toxicity
Gas under pressure (compressed gas)	Aspiration hazard
Contact with water emits flammable gas	Simple asphyxiant
Combustible Dust	Hazard not otherwise classified
Hazard Not Otherwise Classified
