This unit helps protect the nation's war-fighter weapon systems, information systems, computer networks and installation critical infrastructure. As a Cyberspace Warfare Operator, the incumbent will maintain Combat Mission Ready (CMR) status to perform the phases of a Cyberspace Protection Team (CPT) or Cyber-to-Physical mission. Shall lead, manage and develop Ops Flts as Flt Chief; or cyber programs NCOIC to include Operations Planning, Stan & Eval, and/or Ops Training. Performs duties to develop, sustain, and enhance network capabilities to defend national interests from attack. Supervise, conduct, and document section training; work with individuals to develop career goals and personnel plans. Provides leadership with recommendations and guidance on technical and personnel issues. Trains, mentors and evaluates personnel in technical skills, management and leadership. Organizes and manages personnel, technical and administrative tasks. Performs other duties as assigned.
