- Ability to read, understand, interpret and administer Air Force Instructions (AFIs), laws, and directives.
- Ability to effectively communicate both orally and in writing with all levels of personnel to include National Guard Bureau.
- Ability to effectively lead personnel.
- Must exhibit exceptional integrity and leadership qualities, while exemplifying the Core Values of the Air Force and the Air National Guard.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION:
 Current members of the Washington Air National Guard or anyone eligible for enlistment in the Washington Air National Guard.

WORKING CONDITIONS:
 The UTA working conditions are typically within the 141st Security Forces Squadron at Fairchild AFB, WA. However, member should be prepared to be deployed and employed in sensitive or hostile environments created by terrorism, sabotage, nuclear, chemical, biological, conventional warfare, or natural disaster. Member must be capable of carrying/wearing equipment in excess of 75 pounds for extended periods of time.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

This is a Traditional Air National Guard position as a Logistics Superintendent in the 141st Security Forces Squadron. This is a leadership position vital to the mentoring and development of the Enlisted force.
