SUMMARY OF DUTIES:			
This position is located in the Air National Guard, Logistics Readiness Squadron, and Vehicle Management Flight. Duties and responsibilities: develops, manages and implements daily, weekly, monthly, and yearly operational and maintenance plans for assigned general and special purpose vehicles and a variety of equipment. Projects parts, contract services, funds, and personnel required. Coordinates master maintenance schedules. Assigns work priorities for all scheduled/unscheduled maintenance. Schedules vehicles and equipment for repair, inspections, and preventative maintenance based on consideration of shop capability and requirements of the unit. Performs analysis on a wide range of production indicators to assist in improving productivity or in determining causes of production delays. The incumbent acts as the primary source of expertise for material control, to include ordering parts and equipment items through SBSS and tool inventory of tool crib and composite tool kits (CTK's) annually.
