GENERAL INTENT FOR USE OF FUNDS: To provide local educational agencies (LEAs), institutions of higher education (IHEs), and other education related entities with emergency assistance to address the impact that the coronavirus pandemic has had, and continues to have, on students and parents across the nation. This includes both continuing to provide educational services while schools and campuses are closed and supporting the on-going functionality of those schools and campuses.

Support technological capacity and access – including hardware and software, connectivity, and instructional expertise – to support remote learning for all students

Support remote learning by developing new informational and academic resources and expanding awareness of, and access to, best practices and innovations in remote learning and support for students, families, and educators

Assessment of the barriers to implementing effective remote learning for all students

Adopt or improve remote learning that serves all students, including students with disabilities, students from low-income families, charter school students, and non-public school students.

GENERAL INTENT FOR USE OF FUNDS:

Rethinking K-12 Education Models (REM) is a new opportunity that will fund adaptable, innovative learning opportunities for K-12 students impacted by the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). The competition is open to State educational agencies (SEAs) that demonstrate coronavirus burden and propose projects in one of the three following areas:

1. Microgrants for families, so that States can ensure families have access to the technology and educational services needed to advance learning;
2. Statewide virtual learning and course access programs, so that students can access a full range of subjects, even those not taught in the traditional or assigned setting; or,
3. New, field-initiated models for providing remote education not yet imagined, to ensure that every child is learning and preparing to be successful.
