Meeting location driving instructions

Clover Park Technical College in Lakewood

From NB I-5 or SB I-5, use Exit #127 (Also marked SR-512). Go WEST on SR-512 (Staying in the right lane) SR-152 will (very soon) end at South Tacoma Way. Turn Right and go North a very short distance and turn left on 100th St. (Stay in right lane) Follow 100th St (going West), immediately after crossing rail-road tracks, turn Right onto Lakeview. Stay on Lakeview until you see sign on left for Clover Park Technical College. Turn left, into the College. Look for building on your right with large tower on the East side. This is Building 11, The conference room is in the NW corner of this building. Park anywhere on the South side of Bldg 11. Enter via the Western most door on the South Side – Proceed down hall to entrance to KVTI. Conference room is straight ahead.

Kittcom in Ellensburg

From EB I-90, exit 106, take the off ramp and cross over the freeway and proceed through the roundabout. From WB I-90, exit 106, at the stop sign at the top of the off ramp, turn right and proceed through the roundabout.

From the roundabout, proceed straight ahead about 1 mile. As the roadway raises in an overpass to cross over the railroad tracks, at the top of the overpass there is a "T" intersection. Turn left there onto Reecer Creek Road. Proceed about 1 mile and turn right onto Bowers Road. Proceed about 1 1/2 miles to Airport Road. Turn right onto Airport Road and proceed south one block and turn left onto Elmview Road. Once on Elmview turn into the first driveway on the right into KITTCOM's parking lot. (There's a 140 foot tower on the property, so you'll know you're at the right place.)

Along the route from I-90 there are symbolic airport signs with arrows pointing the way. https://www.kittcom.org/driving-directions/
