Storage options

- You all have 55 gallons right now. Do you know where?
- Where else do you have water stored?





Can't store enough?

- Boil water
- Use bleach as last resort

 If you can, try to save up at least a week's supply by following these steps



- 1. Check renewal date: renew as early as you can
- 2. Start new bottle as soon as you renew
- 3. Set aside remaining medication from previous bottle instead of finishing
- 4. Make sure to cycle through your emergency supply
