Oversees squadron resource utilization and protection of resource programs. Coordinates and oversees Commanders Support Staff functions and all Commanders programs. Oversees unit maintenance section and oversees the management of all support function equipment and tools. Coordinates with Unit Commander to establish Unit readiness objectives and policies. Oversees the deployment training of Unit personnel to meet operational requirements. Exercises responsibility for establishing and maintaining a high level of readiness for assigned personnel.
