## **Prominent Gaps**

P.O.E.T.E. Area	Gap
Organization	<ul> <li>Staffing levels remained generally the same, but most cannot fill vacancies.</li> <li>Law Enforcement in local jurisdictions needs more staffing to devote to building prevention and protection core capabilities.</li> <li>State, county, and municipal jurisdictions do not have enough resources to conduct accurate assessments.</li> <li>Making accurate assessments on critical infrastructure is near impossible.</li> </ul>
Training	<ul> <li>Many jurisdictions have lost training budgets and most training has all but stopped.</li> <li>Communities need more diverse in course offerings.</li> <li>Law Enforcement needs training in prevention and protection core capabilities.</li> <li>ICS training is needed across the state including in law enforcement.</li> <li>In-person training is needed.</li> </ul>
Exercise	<ul> <li>Many jurisdictions were unable to conduct exercises due to the COVID19 response, fires and civil unrest.</li> </ul>
