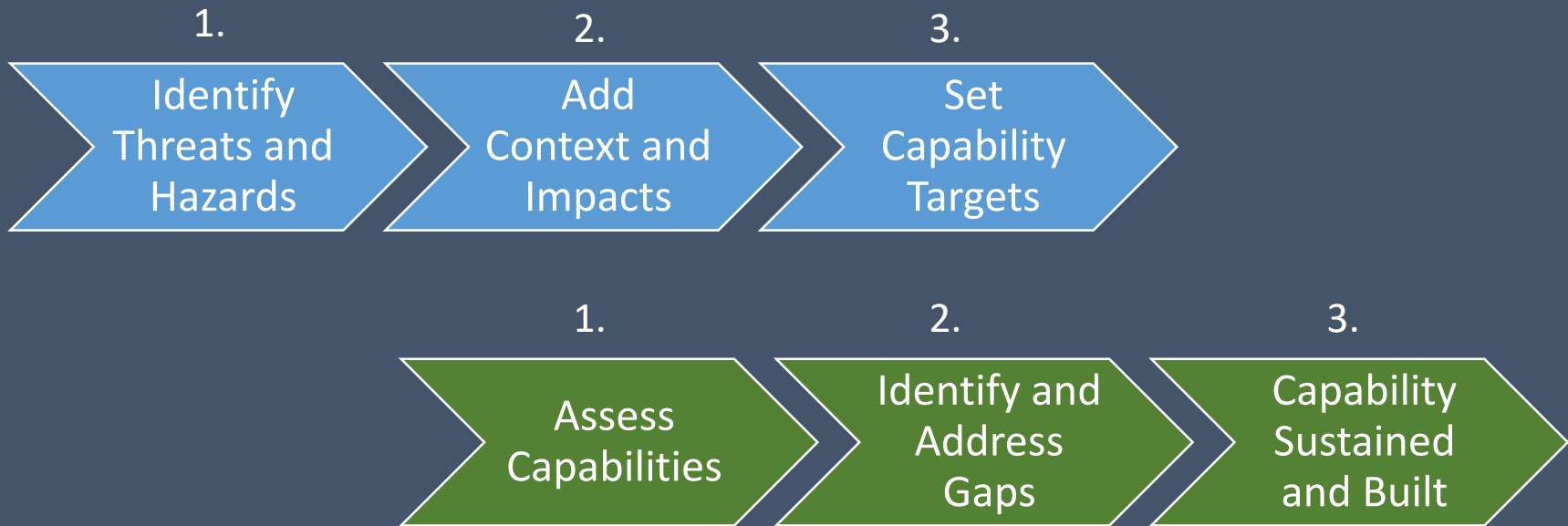

Prominent Gaps

P.O.E.T.E. Area	Gap
Organization	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Staffing levels remained generally the same, but most cannot fill vacancies.• Law Enforcement in local jurisdictions needs more staffing to devote to building prevention and protection core capabilities.• State, county, and municipal jurisdictions do not have enough resources to conduct accurate assessments.• Making accurate assessments on critical infrastructure is near impossible.
Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Many jurisdictions have lost training budgets and most training has all but stopped.• Communities need more diverse in course offerings.• Law Enforcement needs training in prevention and protection core capabilities.• ICS training is needed across the state including in law enforcement.• In-person training is needed.
Exercise	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Many jurisdictions were unable to conduct exercises due to the COVID19 response, fires and civil unrest.

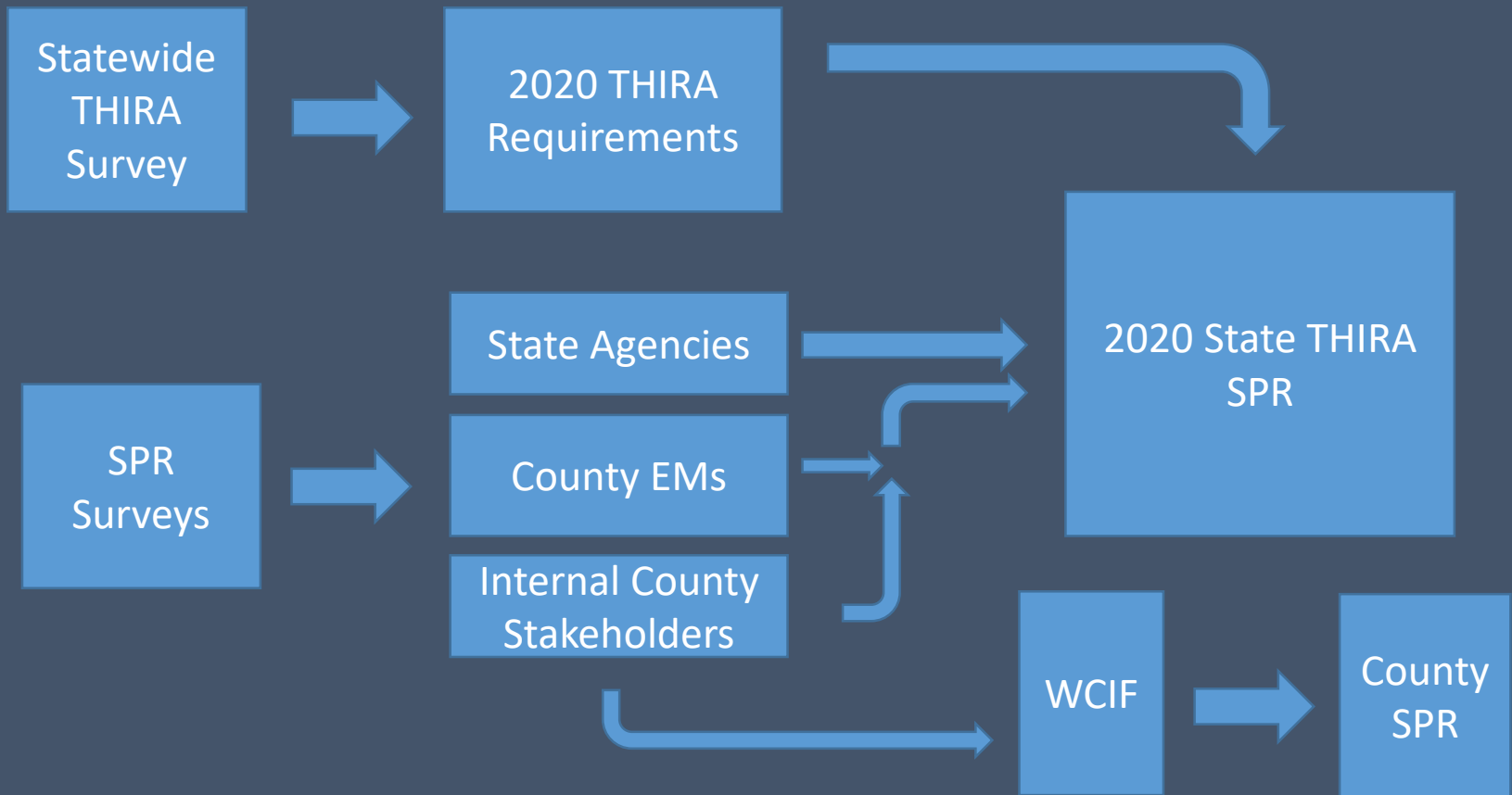
