Served in any branch of the military as a chaplain and achieved the rank of at least O-3 and are promotable. 5. Must be a U.S. citizen. 6. Have an Ecclesiastical Endorsement from a DoD-recognized endorser. 7. No convictions by courts-martial or by civilian courts (except for minor traffic violations or similar infractions) 8. No disciplinary action for engaging in an unprofessional or inappropriate relationship 9. No record of disciplinary action for financial irresponsibility, domestic violence or child abuse <p>Be commissioned by 40 years of age, age waivers may be available.</p>

Chaplains develop and execute religious support plans and evaluate outcomes to ensure their effectiveness. 2. Conduct worship services, liturgies, and rites. Provide counseling, pastoral care, unit engagement, religious education, morale programs, spiritual renewal, lay leadership programs, and humanitarian outreach opportunities. Represent faith and military communities in religious, patriotic, and civic events. Maintain liaison with civilian clergy and organizations to remain current in their specialty and areas of interest to Chaplain Corps programs.

3. Advise leadership at all levels on spiritual, religious, ethical, moral, morale, and quality of life matters.
