SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:			
This is not an entry level position. Potential candidate should have proven exceptional leadership qualities and interpersonal skills. Must be able to participate in worldwide mobility taskings, wing deployments and local contingencies. Knowledge of and experience in Air National Guard and Air Force leadership & management concepts, practices and objectives is highly desirable. Wide-range of civilian emergency management training and experiences (especially through NG DOMOPS) desired. Successful candidate must demonstrate clear potential for success as a leader in the Washington Air National Guard.			
OTHER REQUIREMENTS:			
Member is expected to attend all UTAs, Annual Field Training, and remain eligible for world-wide deployments. Previous completion of Professional Military Education according to grade required. Must have a current and passing physical fitness score.			
AREA OF CONSIDERATION:			
All members of the Washington Air National Guard and those eligible to enlist in the Washington Air National Guard.			
WORKING CONDITIONS:			
This is a mobility position; the successful candidate will maintain personal readiness and comply with all mobility training and other requirements. Though normal duties occur in an office environment, occasional duties may be performed in the field or in an industrial or recreational setting. Selectee's primary duty is on the HQ Air Staff, and will perform duty in the WA Joint Operations Center working with partners from the WA Army National Guard and WA Emergency Management Division. Member is expected to be on the planning staff amongst seasoned Army and Air Guard Field Grade Officers.			
SUMMARY OF DUTIES:			
Prepares, plans, trains, educates, and equips personnel and installation leaders on ways to prepare for, prevent, respond to, maintain mission capability and recover from threat events including major accidents, natural disasters, weapons of mass destruction and wartime chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and high-yield explosive (CBRNE) attacks. Performs detection, monitoring, sampling, warning and reporting of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear (CBRN) events. Provides expert advice for commanders to make risk-based decisions during all phases of emergency response operations
