FY19 HMEP

- Years 1 and 2 in progress
- Year 3 allocation received PHMSA
 - Federal funds: \$285,941
 - State Application due to PHMSA March 11, 2021
 - Award expected by end of September 2021
 - Subrecipient agreements will be sent after award is received (Sept/Oct)



Year 1 & 2 Reallocation

- Per September 2020 SERC meeting, an Activity Request was submitted to PHMSA to reallocate unused 2020/2021 event costs to:
 - Cover travel/per diem costs for 100 attendees at future in-person HazMat Workshop and LEPC/Tribal Conference (previously only budgeted for ~70 attendees/event)
 - NOTE: Both meals AND light refreshments costs are <u>not</u> allowable
 - Purchase additional ERGs



Year 3 Allocations

- Based on previous SERC vote, funds were allocated based on the following percentages:
 - 9% SAA M&A: \$25,735
 - 6% HazMat Workshop \$17,156
 - 6% LEPC/Tribal Conference: \$17,156
 - 70% WSP-FPB: \$200,159
 - 9% LEPC: \$25,735 (only \$21,112 available)
- YEAR 3 TOTAL: 285,941



Year 3 Allocations (cont.)

• \$21,112 Available for competitive LEPC/Tribal applications

• Timeline

- February 5: applications due
- Mid/End-February: Workgroup review and recommend applications for funding
 - NEED: A few volunteers to comprise Workgroup
- Mid/End-February: Workgroup review and recommend applications for funding
- NLT March 1: Email overall State Application to the SERC for review
 - Per the HMEP Requirement, the SERC must be provided an opportunity to review the grant application



Year 3 Allocations (cont.)

- Already have \$51,119 budgeted for 2022 in-person HazMat Workshop and LEPC/Tribal Conference
- QUESTION: Do we want to reallocate Year 3 event funding (totaling \$34,312) to different projects?
 - Any ideas?
