<b>WORKING CONDITIONS:</b>			
Work is accomplished primarily in a shop environment but may involve activity of a more physical nature to include lifting and equipment operation in a field environment. As a primary mobility position, member may be deployed to austere conditions for extended periods. Work conditions include indoors and outdoors in hot, cold, and inclement weather.			
<b>SUMMARY OF DUTIES:</b>			
Responsible for the accurate interpretation of numerous manufacture drawings, specifications, operating instruction, and test procedures, to troubleshoot, calibrate, align and repair a variety of highly complex pieces of powered support equipment. This includes identifying, repairing or replacing numerous electronic components. Uses a variety of test equipment to determine repair requirements. Corrects maintenance problems in a timely manner. Trains and documents training requirements for other personnel assigned to shop. Document Training Business Area (TBA) and document maintenance data collection. Maintain Technical Orders and equipment part ordering forms.			
<b>SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:</b>			
Must possess integrity of the highest level, with knowledge of AGE maintenance, be proficient in TBA, specifically the 2A6X2 career field and be able to participate in worldwide tasking, deployments and local contingencies.
