

WebEOC Quick Reference Guide

WebEOC is a Crisis Information System, a common operating Picture, is used for Emergency Management documentation, and Situational Awareness. It includes the Resource Tracker, (the PPE Ordering Board), Situation Reports, Incident Action Plans, Sign In/Out, Activity Logs, Significant Events, Other ICS Web Forms, Dashboards, and more.

WebEOC is incident based using the same boards. You can think of an incident as a container. Everything you put into the incident stays contained within it.




