<b>SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:</b>			
<b>This is not an entry-level position.</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Must possess strong senior leadership qualities with character of the highest integrity.</li> <li>2. Knowledge of computer network operations and AF network cyber surety practices.</li> <li>3. Demonstrate the ability to deploy network intrusion detection capabilities.</li> <li>4. Plans, organizes, and directs cyberspace support activities and programs.</li> <li>5. Performs cyberspace operations crew duties. Maintains readiness to support and conduct operations. Applies current directives for operating networks, supporting mission execution and cyberspace operations activities.</li> <li>6. Demonstrate a critical thinking process in troubleshooting computer networks.</li> <li>7. Must demonstrate excellent interpersonal and communication skills, both orally and in writing at all levels.</li> </ol>			
<b>OTHER REQUIREMENTS:</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Previous completion of the Non-Commissioned Officer Academy or correspondence is <i>mandatory</i>. TSgt applicants who have been accepted to attend NCO Academy in-residence or who are currently enrolled in and have substantially completed NCO Academy may be considered, if all other requirements for promotion to MSgt have been met.</li> <li>2. Expected to attend all UTAs, Annual Field Training, and remain eligible for World Wide Deployments.</li> <li>3. Supervise, conduct, and document section training; work with individuals to develop career goals and personal plan.</li> </ol>			
<b>AREA OF CONSIDERATION:</b>			
All members of the Washington Air National Guard and those who are prior service and eligible to enlist in WA ANG.			
<b>WORKING CONDITIONS:</b>			
Work will normally be conducted inside and subject to 24 hour shift work. This position is worldwide deployable.

Conducts IA risk and vulnerability assessments; ensures enterprise IA policies fully support all legal and regulatory requirements and ensures IA policies are applied in new and existing IT resources. Monitors enterprise IA policy compliance and provides recommendations for effective implementation of IT security controls. Makes periodic evaluation and assistance visits, notes discrepancies, and recommends corrective actions. Audits and enforces the compliance of IA procedures and investigates security-related incidents. Operates and manages IA tools and IA-enabled tools. Integrates tools with other IT functions to protect and defend IT resources. Manages the IA program and monitors emerging security technologies for best practices.
