SECO Update		
9:02	Adam Wasserman	
Training [Trueblood Settlement]	Last class of the Phase One training is scheduled to occur soon. Will begin Phase Two shortly. All will be required to take said training classes; encouraged all to begin their training, do not have to wait until your county's Phase is reached.	
Close of Biennium	All contracts have been sent out, requesting a quick turnaround. Asked all to turn-in reports early to aide in a smooth close-out process.	
Text-to-911	Three (3) counties that have inquired about it; Three (3) counties considering switching over to the integrated solution.	
Integrated COOP Plan	Asked all to look at their COOP plans; giving the ability to see, from the entire state's perspective, how fail overs will work, especially for major events such as a Cascadia earthquake.	
NextGen 911	Still pushing legislation on the \$15 billion for Next Generation 911. Still looking to put it into the infrastructure bill, but could possibly break it out and include it somewhere else.	
FCC/911 Fee Diversion	<ul> <li>The FCC has their Strike Force going on for 911 fee diversion.</li> <li>They have three work groups</li> <li>#1 is determining the effectiveness of any federal laws, (i.e. regulations, policies and practices, or budgetary or jurisdictional constraints) regarding how the federal government can most expeditiously end diversion by state or taxing jurisdiction of 911 fees. [Cathy Jones-Gooding is a member of said work group].</li> <li>#2 to consider whether criminal penalties would further prevent diversion by a state/taxing jurisdiction of 911 fees.</li> <li>#3 is determining the impacts of diversion by a state or taxing jurisdiction of 911 fees.</li> <li>Expect the FCC's definition of "Fee Diversion" to be published on July 25<sup>th</sup>; once published, time for public comment prior to enactment. Keep an eye out; will push out once we see it.</li> <li>Will be presented to legislature, on fee diversion, by September; laws will be enacted.</li> </ul>

	Adam confirmed that the State would be the collector/holder of said info.
