FY19 HMEP

Years 1 and 2 in progress

- Upcoming biannual report due to PHMSA; Subrecipients must submit reports by November 15
- Financial Update as of September 17

Allocated	\$ 579,679
Expended	\$ 326,381
Balance	\$ 253,298

- Year 3 allocation received PHMSA
 - Federal funds: \$285,941
 - State Application submitted to PHMSA March 11, 2021
 - Award expected by end of September 2021
 - Subrecipient agreements will be sent after award is received (Sept/Oct)



Looking forward to FY22 HMEP

Tentative Timeline

- March 2022: Grant announced and NOFO released
 - Competitive applications open to LEPCs/TEPCs
- May 2022: Application due to PHMSA
- September 2022: Award received for new 3-year Period of Performance
