You can be prepared for earthquakes and other disasters in 3 easy steps:

Learn your hazards:

Earthquakes and many other disasters can happen in WA, such as severe winter weather, tsunamis, floods, wildfires, pandemics, civil unrest, and volcano eruptions.

Make a plan:

As a family, decide on your local and distant meeting spots. Choose an out-of-area contact who can relay messages in an emergency. Sign up for local emergency alerts and know alternate routes to home/work/school.

Build kits:

Have 2 weeks of supplies at home and smaller kits in vehicles and at work/school. Everyone in the family needs a go-bag, including pets.
