## Oil Transportation Safety Act 2015

- Grants to emergency responders to assist with oil spill and hazardous materials response and firefighting equipment
- Determine the need for additional, new, or updated equipment or resources
- Prioritize funding based on need for equipment and resources

## Who can apply?

#### Eligible

- Washington counties, cities, and municipalities
- Other state recognized local governments
  - Ports
  - Public utility districts
  - Other special purpose districts
- Federal recognized tribal governments
- Washington state agencies

#### Ineligible

- Private entities
- Nonprofit organizations
- Non-government organizations



## **Project Eligibility**

#### Grant match and ceiling

- No match requirements
- No ceiling for grants projects
- State funded

#### Limitations

- Reimburse approved costs directly associated with the project
- Cannot be used to reimburse salaries and/or benefits
- Cannot be used to support events that are part of the normal operating environment




## Ineligible Projects

- Does not support implementation of emergency response plans
- Capital construction
- Grant application preparation
- Project administration or overhead
- Firefighting apparatus
- Mechanical oil collection

- PFOS/PFOA firefighting foam
- Excavators
- Cleaning and decontamination of response equipment
- Maintenance or service packages with dates beyond the grant agreement





#### Fun Facts- since 2017

- \$17.4 million in requests
- \$6.8 million awarded
- \$5.8 million reimbursed
- >400 persons trained
- >90% 2007 cache trailers received maintenance





#### 2017

- 42 applications \$2.25 mil
- 30 grants awarded \$770k

## 2017 -19

- 30 applications \$3.56 mil
- 22 grants awarded \$3.1 mil

## 2019 -21


- 40 applications \$5.1 mil

- awards TBD


