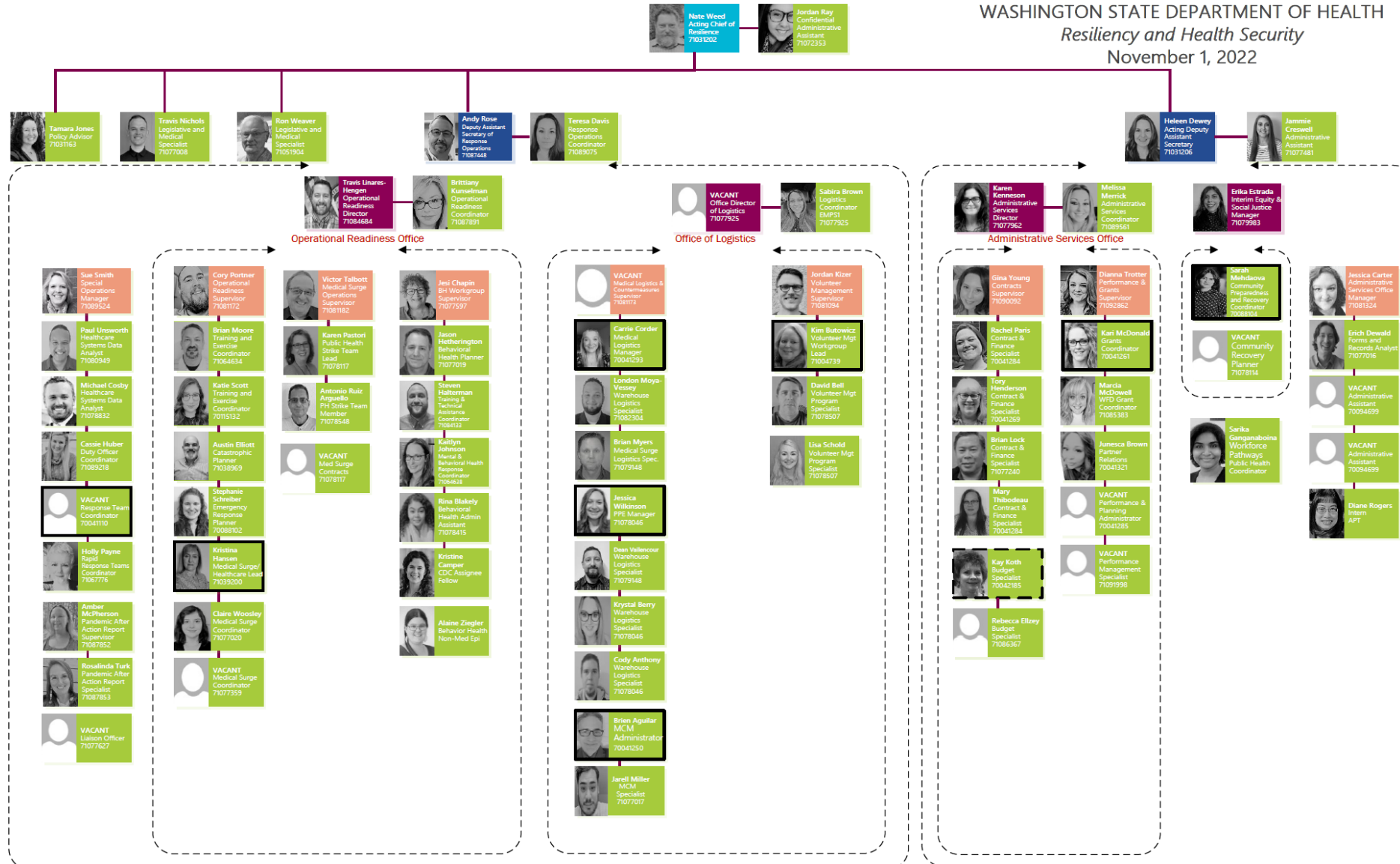

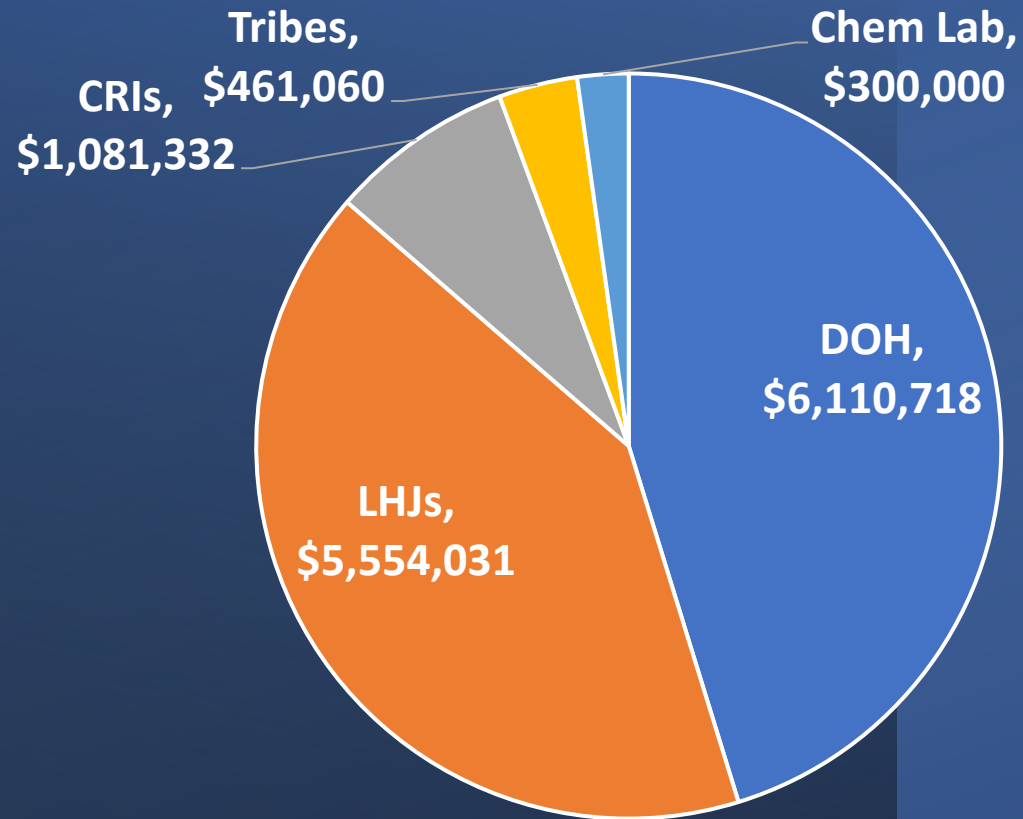

 - First time this office has really focused on outside federal grant funding to support critical work



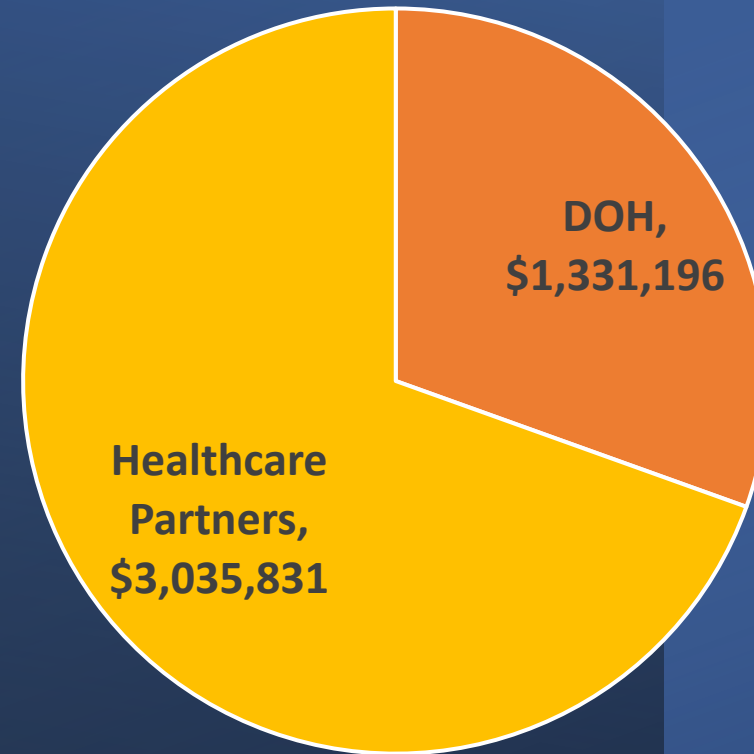
CDC Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Grant
