They ensure the coordination, development, and implementation of a number of user and customer-oriented training requirements for SharePoint, Records Management, Freedom of Information Act, Privacy Act, and other required programs. They also provide Wing-level management of these same programs. The NCOIC oversees the development and maintenance of Wing content on local and Air Force Portal platforms. Additionally, they provide development and maintenance of Wing level databases.

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:
