

Foundational Principle/Issue

Equity



Task Force Experience

Stop treating marginalized communities as a paternalistic afterthought



General Experience

Communities are generally engaged after the fact, if at all



Improved planning, decision-making and preparation to eliminate disparate outcomes

Example B: Potential Flow From Foundational Principle/Issue to Recommendations

Foundational Principle/Issue

Administrative Systems



Task Force Perspective or Finding

Too many systems to learn, coupled with lack of coordinated communication creates barriers to get things done at local levels



General Experience

Too complex for communities/local systems to work with - results in forced compliance vs true partnerships



High Level Goal

Simplified administrative structures, funding and requirements to allow local participants to be more effective with resources



High Level Recommendations

Evaluate how confusing and conflicting admin functions create barriers to effective local (and other) response
