CAMP MURRAY - CONTRACTOR FACT SHEET

- A. <u>CAMP MURRAY GATE ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS</u> Camp Murray is a controlled access installation. Access to Camp Murray for the Pre-Bid Walk-Through and/or submission of bid requires pre-enrollment. Failure to pre-enroll could result in significant delays in processing through the visitor center. From Washington Military Department website (https://mil.wa.gov/camp-murray-gate-access), scroll down to the "Pre-vetting and Expedited Entry" heading and select the "DBIBS Pre-Enrollment website" link then follow the steps below.
 - 1. Click "Get Started" on the DBIDS Pre-Enrollment Page.
 - 2. Enter your complete First, Middle, and Last name with any suffix
 - 3. Enter your date of birth in Month, Day, and Year.
 - 4. Enter your Country of Birth and Country of Citizenship.
 - 5. Under "Primary Identifier", select your ID Type. This can be.

- 18. Enter the Start and End Date for your visit (for single day visits, use the same date).
- 19. Enter your Purpose of Visit, as well as retyping the Sponsor Information (Steps 14 & 15), as well as your Start / End Date of your visit (18).

- Click the check box to acknowledge that the information you entered will be used for vetting to determine fitness to enter the installation in accordance with Department of Defense and local policies.
- 21. Click "Submit".
- 22. Print this page or write down the alpha-numeric code provided and email it, along with a copy of your photo ID to your sponsor to submit to Security Forces to create your pass. If approved for entry, your visitor's pass will be emailed using the information provided to your sponsor.

On the day of your visit, if you have not received confirmation that you have been preenrolled, you must enter Camp Murray through the visitors' lane at the Camp Murray Main Gate (off Portland Ave SW and Boundary St); otherwise, present your printed visitor's pass at the main entrance lane.

- B. CAMP MURRAY REGULATIONS All visitors to Camp Murray shall comply with the following.
 - 1. Follow all established laws, regulations, and directives that provide for the good order and discipline and public safety while on Camp Murray.
 - 2. Provide valid identification credentials, such as a driver's license or photo ID. Guests who bring vehicles on base must possess and display on request appropriate vehicle documentation (registration, proof of insurance and valid driver's license).
 - 3. Visitors could be asked by on-duty Security personnel to consent to search of their vehicle while entering, on, or leaving Camp Murray.
 - 4. If a vehicle belonging to a visitor is towed or impounded on Camp Murray, they are responsible for all costs and actions associated with towing and recovery of the vehicle.
 - 5. All occupants must wear seatbelts and restraining devices while operating on Camp Murray.
 - 6. Limit all movement to authorized traffic ways. Off-limit areas are identified by signs showing "Restricted Area" or "Controlled Area".
