1. Opening Comments

a. Provided brief introduction as the new EQCC chair.

2. WAARNG Environmental Point of contacts

a. Announced the Environmental Program Manager position is vacant and Thomas Blume is the acting EPM.

3. Action items from 4th QTR

- a. Reviewed action items and extended suspense date:
- (1) medical monitoring new date 31 Dec 23 also mentioned this is contract for State employees Thomas explained what this program is and the need for it
 - (2) removal of items blocking drums at Redmond COL Mushallo will provide point of contact for them to remove items

4. WAARNG Program Area Updates

- a. EMS slide 7
- (1) EMS objectives and targets only 9/18 appointed members voted by the 21 Jul 23 suspense date. BG Borchers stated to give members a new date of 15 Sep and send him a list of those who do not respond.
- (2) EMS leadership training Timmie provided background on the training and acknowledged the link is now live. EQCC leadership's suspense for completion is 9 Nov 23.

 - (1) lead-acid vehicle batteries DLA has a new contract in place and moving forward with battery removal
 - (2) Camp Murray Episodic generation event occurred 11 Sep 23 and final report is due to the Department of Ecology by 11 Oct 23
 - e. Spill Prevention, control and countermeasures slide 13
 - (1) Longview lead contamination in paint chips clean up completed and issue closed



(2) Two new spills reported: JBLM UTES- fuel spill which was cleaned up; and Anacortes pipe from previous Underground Storage Tank (UST) – contractors digging found pipe and noticed liquid around area – halted progression and did immediate notification to CFMO – placed absorbents around pipe until further investigation from Environmental staff.

5. WAANG Environmental Updates - slide 14

- a. Stormwater Management Plan and MOU Cheryl submitted inspection forms to Timmie as required in the SWMP. The MOU is being developed by Timmie and Cheryl is available to assist if requested.
 - b. Back-up generator delivery for building 113 set for Nov 23.
- c. BG Borchers noted that since the NPDES permit was made out to the WMD then the permit and documents for that permit need to have the TAG signature.
