<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This is a commissioning opportunity, and is also open to current/former 19ZXBs, O1-O4. 2. Successful completion of TACP Officer Phase Two assessment. 3. Must maintain physical and combat ready status qualification for parachutist duty and Joint Terminal Attack Controller (JTAC) qualification. 4. Must pass the OSOR Tier 2 Operator Fitness Test. 5. Final acceptance is contingent on SWA medical clearance according to AFI 48-123 and its associated SWA-specific requirements outlined in the Medical Standards Directory (MSD). 6. Must possess, or can obtain, a TOP SECRET security clearance. 			
OTHER REQUIREMENTS:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open to current members of the WA ANG, or those eligible to join. 2. Expected to attend all UTAs, Annual Field Training, additional specialized currency training events, and remain eligible for Worldwide Deployment. AFSPECWAR currency requirements require an average of 30 additional days of Title 32 active duty throughout the calendar year. 3. Prior-enlisted and prior-service 1Z3XX accessions may go through a modified training pipeline with approval of the 19Z CFM and gaining MAJCOM hiring authority.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:			
<p>Conduct troop leading procedures, joint planning process, command and control principles and procedures; small unit tactics, fieldcraft and land navigation; voice and digital tactical ground-to-ground and air-to-ground communications; small arms proficiency; tactical combat casualty care; survival and evasion. Employment methods: dismounted, mounted, airborne (static-line parachute), and rotary-wing insertion/extraction. TACP Officers will focus on: Close air support procedures, terminal attack control, theater air-ground system, surface-to-surface and air-to-surface fires weapons and effects; intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance; electronic warfare and airspace management. Officers filling Flight Commander roles will</p>			

be responsible for administrative duties encompassing training cycle planning, performance reports, recognition, and development of junior members.
