Member must remain eligible for world-wide deployments and may be required to travel overseas for exercises. Completion of Professional Military Education according to grade required. Must have a current and passing physical fitness score.

WORKING CONDITIONS:			
Though normal duties occur in an office environment, occasional duties may be performed in the field or in an industrial or recreational setting. Selectee's primary duty is on the WA ANG Staff, and she/he will participate with the Joint Planning with partners from the WA Army National Guard in the WA JFHQ.
