MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION:			
Member must possess a 3P0X1 and be a SMSgt or above with minimum of 17 years' time in service; current, passing Air Force fitness test; CCAF degree. Must have and maintain a SECRET security clearance or higher			
AREA OF CONSIDERATION:			
Any member in the Air National Guard or able to enlist or transfer to the Washington Air National Guard.			
WORKING CONDITIONS:			
The UTA working conditions are typically within the 141st Security Forces Squadron at Fairchild AFB, WA. However, member should be prepared to be deployed and employed in sensitive or hostile environments created by terrorism, sabotage, nuclear, chemical, biological, conventional warfare, or natural disaster. Member must be capable of carrying/wearing equipment in excess of 75 pounds for extended periods of time.			
SUMMARY OF DUTIES:			
This is a Traditional Air National Guard position as the Senior Enlisted Leader of the 141 st Security Forces Squadron. This is a leadership position vital to the mentoring and development of the Enlisted Force. It requires a close working relationship with the 141st Security Forces Squadron Commander and other command staff in order to ensure all training and readiness standards are met. Member will oversee and manage various functional areas ensuring mission success overseas and at home station. The selected member must possess the ability to maintain unit morale through uniformity, good order, discipline, and integrity. This position is a Traditional position but will also have required pre- and post-drill requirements.			
SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:			
Must have deployment experience. Must have law enforcement and/or corrections experience (military and/or civilian). Must have supervisory and leadership experience at the Flight, Squadron, or Group level. Must epitomize the finest qualities of a military leader and mirror the Air Force Core Values. Proven leadership and communications skills in a military environment. Possess the ability to effectively communicate both written and verbally with all members within the chain of command, peer group, and subordinates. Overall image must exceed minimum standards. Member must bring substantial institutional, operational, and functional experience as well as strong management skills to the organization and the Wing. Must be able to participate in worldwide mobility taskings, Wing deployments, and local contingencies. No disciplinary action pending.
