memory of individual processes and analyzes it using built-in tools and capabilities. Provides analytic expertise in network traffic and understand network traffic signatures and discover anomalies through net flows and traffic analysis. Will identify, assess, and			
mitigate intrusions into networks that are vital to Department of Defense Information Network security and conduct packet			
capturing, traffic and analyzes full packet captures using Graphic User Interface or command-line based tools. Assists in
