Evaluates and assesses vulnerabilities of customer network and application server hardware, operating system software, and peripheral network equipment. Conducts analyses of network usage, hardware and software capabilities, ineffective practices or procedures, equipment shortcomings, and other relevant factors. Able to enumerate, analyze, gain access, and exploit enterprise networks to highlight vulnerabilities and assess effectiveness of hardening actions. Able to write comprehensive technical reports and brief high-level stakeholders on vulnerabilities and risk mitigation. Able to perform cyber threat emulation of Advance Persistent Threat activity. Assists with oversight and maintenance of the squadron's digital training range(s), a suite of servers, routers, switches, and other devices which can be configured with a variety of different operating systems in various versions, and with pre-programmed vulnerabilities. Experience working within Operational Technology networks is desired.
