SUMMARY OF DUTIES:			
Security Forces Craftsmen provide leadership and management of programs and assigned operational personnel within the Security Forces Squadron. Interprets and enforces policies and applicable directives related to the use of force, up to and including the use of deadly force. Manages SF capabilities through the functions of installation security, air base defense, and law enforcement. Deployments include sensitive areas or hostile environments created by terrorism, sabotage, nuclear, chemical, biological, or conventional warfare. Must be able to carry and wear equipment in excess of 75 pounds for long periods of time. Other duties as assigned.			
OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Never received non-judicial punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice which resulted in either reduction or suspended reduction in grade, or correctional custody for offenses involving substantiated drug abuse as defined in AFI 36-27801, Social Actions Program, acts of larceny, wrongful appropriation, robbery, burglary, housebreaking, or misconduct in combat defined in UCMJ articles 99-106. Never been convicted by a civilian court of a Category 1, 2, or 3 offenses, nor exceeded the accepted number of Category 4 offenses.
