## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION:

#### **SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:**

Knowledge of missions, roles, functions, organizational structures, relationships, operational planning objectives, policies, customs and courtesies, and history of the Air Force; oral, written, and visual communication concepts and principles; traditional and emerging methods and techniques of disseminating information; basic communication theory; legal and ethical considerations surrounding the practice of communication; communication research and analysis; and joint expeditionary operation environments.

# OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Expected to attend all Regularly Scheduled Drills (RSDs), Annual Training (AT), and remain eligible for World Wide Deployments.

#### AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

All members of the Washington Air National Guard and those eligible to enlist in the Washington Air National Guard.

### WORKING CONDITIONS:

Work may be performed in the office or on location. The work is primarily sedentary, although there is some walking, travel, and carrying of lightweight equipment and materials. Assignments may typically require long periods of standing, stooping, or walking. Work is typically performed in adequately lighted and climate-controlled offices. Incumbent may be exposed to varying outdoor weather conditions, but requires no special safety precautions.

- **1.** Responsible for leading two wings and one wing equivalent legal offices at Camp Murray (JBLM) and Fairchild AFB in the provision of legal services to 2,100 Airmen charge with diverse operational mission sets across Washington State and beyond.
- 2. Support legal office inspections in Washington and annually, inspection of at least two other out of state wing legal offices.
- 3. Participate in the ANG JA Regional Manager Program, supporting units within the assigned region
- **4.** Generate and support preventive law initiatives, mentor subordinate paralegals, recruit for wing legal offices.
