Provide air traffic control services IAW FAA, ICAO, and military regulations, operate and maintain air traffic control equipment, including radios, radar, navigation aids, communication systems, issue clearances, instructions, and advisories to pilots to ensure safe and efficient air traffic flow, monitor weather conditions, aid aircraft in distress, and maintain accurate records of air traffic control activities. Deploy to austere and challenging environments with little to no notice. Participate in exercises and drills to enhance readiness.</p>
