POSITION TITLE, GRADE, AFSC:

Materiel Management, E-6, 2S0X1

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION:

- 1. Rank: Must be a Technical Sergeant (E-6) or promotable Staff Sergeant (E-5)
- 2. AFSC Required: Must hold or be eligible for award of AFSC 2S071 (Materiel Management Craftsman).
- 3. Physical Fitness: Must meet current Air Force physical fitness standards with a passing score.
- 4. Security Clearance: Must possess or be eligible for a current SECRET security clearance.
- 5. **Education:** High school diploma or GED required; coursework in math or logistics preferred.
- 6. Medical/Physical Standards: Must be worldwide qualified and meet deployment medical standards.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

1. Eligibility:

- Open to current WA ANG members or those eligible to join the Washington Air National Guard.
- Cross-trainees may be considered with prior logistics experience and ability to obtain 2S0X1 within 12 months.

2. Attendance & Deployment Obligations:

- Must attend all Unit Training Assemblies (UTAs), annual field training, and remain worldwide deployable.
- Must support logistics operations during exercises, inspections, and real-world contingencies.

3. Experience Preference:

• Prior experience with ILS-S, MICAP processing, RSP management, or logistics in a combat/combat support unit is highly preferred.

4. Rank Details:

Must currently hold the grade of E-6 or be promotion-eligible

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Operates in both garrison and deployed environments, supporting joint combat operations and contingency logistics.
- Works in warehouses, supply points, or field environments with exposure to heat, cold, noise, dust, and extended shifts.
- May deploy alongside Tactical Air Control Party (TACP) units and other combat support elements to manage materiel sustainment under austere conditions.
- Requires frequent lifting, moving, and operation of material handling equipment (MHE) and motor vehicles.
- Handles classified, sensitive, hazardous, and pilferable items requiring strict accountability and compliance with regulatory controls.
- Must maintain proficiency in Integrated Logistics System-Supply (ILS-S), mobility readiness spares packages, and UTC-specific logistics systems.
- Requires network access and continuous systems training to maintain security and data integrity.
- Must be capable of supporting short-notice deployments, exercises, and inspections in high-tempo environments.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

- Serves as the senior materiel management NCO for the ASOG, providing subject matter expertise across multiple squadrons and detachments on logistics, accountability, and supply chain integrity.
- Executes Staff Assistance Visits (SAVs) and compliance inspections across subordinate units to ensure adherence to AFMAN 23-122, AFH 23-123, DAFIs, and local SOPs.
- Provides mentorship, upgrade training guidance, and task evaluations for 5- and 3-level 2S0X1 personnel. Ensures alignment with the CFETP 2S0XX and unit type code (UTC) training requirements.
- Reviews and validates mobility readiness spares packages (RSPs), mobility bags, bench stock, and shelf-life item programs across assigned units.
- Conducts trend analysis and develops corrective actions for deficiencies in MICAP processing, document control, inventory accuracy, or ILS-S system usage.
- Advises the Group Commander, Director of Staff, and squadron logistics leads on supply system health, readiness shortfalls, and material posture for deployment.
- Leads coordination efforts with LRS, Maintenance, and other support functions to resolve equipment and supply issues affecting ASOG readiness.
- Manages or supports logistics training plans, MICT checklists, and prepares units for logistics readiness inspections, ORIs, and MAJCOM-directed evaluations.
- Coordinates logistics support for high-tempo field operations, including joint exercises, deployments, and contingency taskings, ensuring accurate kit-out and sustainment flow.
- Maintains advanced proficiency in ILS-S, CRIS, and Defense Logistics systems, and ensures subordinate units are trained and certified on system access and compliance.
