- 4. Must maintain deployability worldwide
- 5. Must attend all UTAs, annual field training, remain eligible for deployment
- 6. Experience preference: Radio communications, ground combat tactics, close-air support
- 7. Hiring details: Will fill E5 / E6 billet per availability and promotion eligibility

AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Operates in high-stress, austere, and often hostile environments with exposure to extreme weather, sleep deprivation, and sustained physical exertion.
- Frequently deployed forward with U.S. and allied Army units, including Special Operations Forces.
- Carries and operates with 60–100+ lbs of combat gear, including radios, batteries, weapons, and survival equipment.
- Conducts dismounted movements over rugged terrain, often under fire or in support of kinetic operations.
- Expected to maintain combat mission readiness with minimal support and under conditions of prolonged isolation.
- Maintains constant situational awareness, multi-tasking between air/ground communications, tactical operations, and unit integration.
- Required to work irregular hours, conduct continuous field training, and remain worldwide deployable at all times.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

- Serves as the primary airpower expert and liaison to ground commanders at the tactical edge of combat.
- Plans, coordinates, and executes precision air strikes in support of U.S. and coalition forces.
- Provides terminal attack control (JTAC-qualified or in training) for CAS platforms including A-10, F-35, AC-130, and UAVs.
- Operates advanced communications gear to maintain real-time C2 across multi-domain operations (air/land/cyber).
- Integrates into ground unit maneuver planning to advise on the full spectrum of air-delivered fires and ISR.
- Conducts mission planning and battle tracking, ensuring rapid integration of lethal and non-lethal airpower.
- Trains continuously in close combat skills, land navigation, fire support coordination, and survival, both CONUS and OCONUS.
- Expected to lead by example under fire, balancing lethality, technical proficiency, and strategic judgment.
