SUBJECT: Rescission of Department Pamphlets

Effective immediately, the following Military Department pamphlets are rescinded:

WAARNG Army Pamphlet 200-1, Dangerous Waste Management Plan, related to the handling of dangerous and hazardous wastes generated by WAARNG activities.

• This pamphlet will be retained by the Environmental Programs Office as the Dangerous Waste Management Plan (DWMP) to be reviewed and updated internally as needed and provided statewide to applicable units/services for the management of waste.

WAARNG Army Pamphlet 200-2, Consolidated Environmental Training Pamphlet, which includes WMD training forms FORM-HR-MF-0512, FORM-HR-MF-0513, and FORM-HR-MF-0514, related to environmental training development and requirements.

• This pamphlet is extremely outdated and has not been historical updated by the Environmental Programs Office. Environmental training requirements are coordinated through either the Environmental Programs Office or the Environmental Quality Control Committee. Per the Cooperative Agreement, Environmental funds are not authorized for projects not related to environmental compliance.

WAARNG Army Pamphlet 200-3, Hazardous Materials Management Program (HMMP), related to the procurement and use of Hazardous Materials to support Washington Army National Guard.

• This pamphlet was updated several years ago but should not be owned by WAARNG Environmental Programs Office. IAW AR 200-1, Section 9.1(1), the HMMP is the responsibility of Deputy Chief of Staff, G4. Per the Cooperative Agreement, environmental funds are not authorized for projects not related to environmental compliance.

WAARNG Army Pamphlet 200-4, Green Cleaning Management Program

• This pamphlet has not been updated since 2016. The Green Cleaning Management Program is not driven by environmental regulations. Per the Cooperative Agreement, environmental funds are not authorized for projects not related to environmental compliance.
