2024 Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) - Grant Round Results

Following is a list of grant sub-applications that were submitted to FEMA on April 16, 2025. This round was nationally competitive with \$600 million available nationally. FMA grants are designed to reduce repetitive flood damage to buildings insured by the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).

If selected by FEMA for further consideration, awards can take 12-18 months to be approved and awarded. The Federal share may range between 75%-90% of the Total Project Cost.
