MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION:			
Bachelor Undergraduate degree (or Graduate degree) required. This position is being offered as a Commissioning Opportunity . Applicant must be less than 33 ½ years of age at the time of interview and commissioned by their 35 th birthday, 38 ½ with prior enlisted service and commissioned by their 40 th birthday. For each year the applicant exceeds age 35, the applicant must have equivalent years of prior enlisted service. (i.e., if 35 years old, must have one year of enlisted service, etc.) No Unfavorable Information Files or criminal convictions. Must possess or be eligible for a DCID 6/4 (Top Secret) security clearance prior to attending technical training. Must have a passing physical assessment. Strong oral and written communication skills are required. Demonstrated ability to prepare written reports and to prepare/present briefings.			
AREA OF CONSIDERATION:			
Current members of the Washington Air National Guard.			
WORKING CONDITIONS:			
Selected individual will work in a high security area. Duties will be performed primarily in an office setting.			
SUMMARY OF DUTIES:			
Coordinates with active duty on operational taskings. Organize and lead intelligence production utilizing crew of intelligence analysts and systems support personnel. Train intelligence and systems personnel to provide intelligence production capability to support the unit's missions. Liaise with National Guard Bureau on personnel and resource issues. Manage resources to further the squadron's mission and training goals.			
OTHER REQUIREMENTS: The 141 OG Squadron will hold a promotion selection board at a date to be determined. Applicants will be notified by phone or text for their appointment. Packages must include a resume, cover letter with letters of recommendation, current vMPF Report, and a current fitness score.
