Creates/updates SOPs and advises the Operations Officer and Commander in the oversight of operational events, exercises, assessments and projects. Oversees management and development of Weapon System tools and documentation, unit SOPs, and lessons learned repositories. Engages with Active Duty, Air National Guard, and Joint cyber community on current best practices, TTPs, and training scenarios. They must be consummate professionals, self-motivated, self-disciplined, and subscribe to the lifelong learning mentality. Can effectively lead a cyber element through the plan, brief, execution, and debrief process to implement defensive strategies to secure mission-critical networks.
